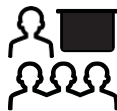
## Planning Application for 1001 Queen Street West - CAMH

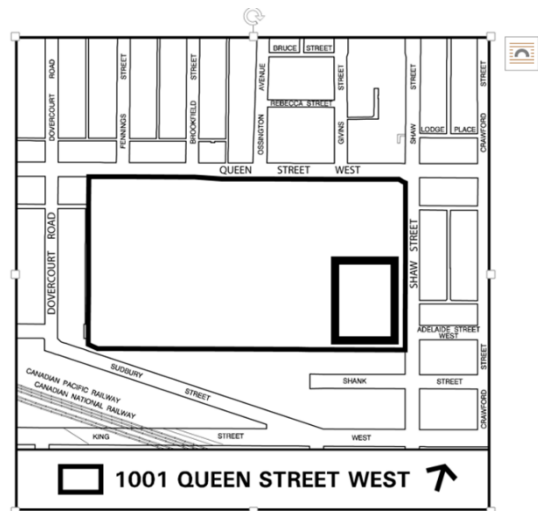
