

Training Course in Repetitive Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation (rTMS)

In collaboration with the University of Toronto, the Temerty Centre for Therapeutic Brain Intervention is offering **psychiatrists** a **4-day program** in the clinical applications of rTMS for psychiatric disorders.

Participants will gain thorough knowledge of the clinical applications of rTMS for treating disorders such as major depression, psychosis, PTSD and OCD as well direct hands-on practice.
